Students will be reviewing courses during homeroom beginning the week of February 3rd. Counselors, administrators, and homeroom teachers will assist students with this process.

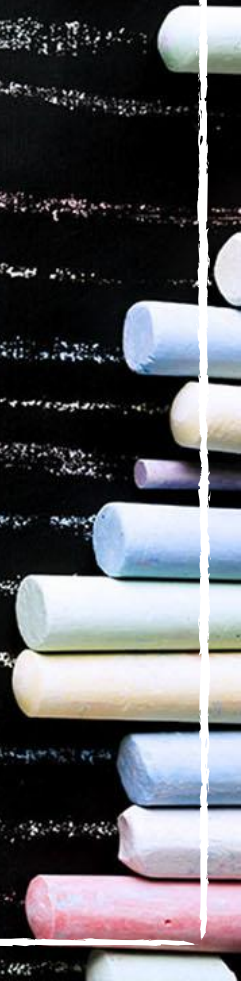
The following items will be helpful when deciding on classes for the 2025-2026 school year.

Required Classes



Religion	4 credits
English	4 credits
History	4 credits
Science	3 credits
Mathematics	3 credits
Intro to Business	.5 credits
Personal Finance	.5 credits (Beginning with the class of 2027)
Phys. Ed	1 credit (.25 per year)
Wellness/Health	.25 credit
Electives	As needed to reach 24 credits

Math for College Bound Students

We strongly recommend that college bound students take 4 years of math. Students with an interest in a STEM field must take a 4th year of math. All college bound students are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the requirements of those colleges in which they are most interested.





Level Change Requirements



Prerequisite averages for level changes.

From Level 1 to CP Level 2 - 90% average

From CP Level 2 to ACP - 93% average

From CP Level 2 to Honors - 93% average

From ACP to Honors - 93% average

From Honors to Advanced Placement - 93% average

There may be additional requirements for some math and science courses. See the Course Catalog for information.

Students who do not meet these requirements will be required to fill out an Override Form.

Students who have below an 85% will need to fill out an Override Form and participate in a meeting with their parents and the Assistant Principal for Academics.



Honors Level Requirements



These guidelines are for students who are currently in Honors level courses who would like to remain in Honors level courses.

- 85% and above may stay in Honors
- 77%-84% requires an Override Form
- Below 77% requires a meeting with the Assistant Principal for Academics in addition to the Override Form
